

AMSA Malaysia Programmes

Asian Medical Students' Conference (AMSC)

The Asian Medical Students' Conference (AMSC) is an annual conference of the Asian Medical Students' Association (AMSA International) that involves the participation of hundreds of medical students from as many as 27 countries around the Asia-Pacific region.

The objective of AMSC lies in creating a platform for a strong, global network of medical students, who as future medical practitioners, will explore and develop their academic knowledge, cultural appreciation and interpersonal skills.

It comprises three main aspects: academic, cultural and social programmes. This event allows medical students from AMSA chapters to congregate, discuss and present their projects and research which were conducted based on the theme agreed upon for the conference that year. In addition, delegates can experience different traditions and customs through the cultural events organised throughout the course of the conference, and gives our Malaysian delegation an opportunity to network and build lifelong friendships.

Proudly, AMSA Malaysia was the host of Asian Medical Students' Conference (AMSC) 1983, 1987, 1992, 1998, 2005, 2013 and 2018.

East Asian Medical Students' Conference (EAMSC)

The East Asian Medical Students' Conference (EAMSC), is an annual conference hosted by various cities around East Asia. At its inception, it aims to inspire delegates to become active in the amelioration of global healthcare problems through networking with other medical students from the East Asian region. More recently, it has expanded to involve delegates from all AMSA-International chapters allowing the exchange of ideas, knowledge and cultural understanding.

The EAMSC continues to inspire medical students to analyse global health issues more closely and to utilise the role of medical students in the promotion of public health. It challenges students to think beyond what is learnt at university through various academic and cultural activities which explore a nominated conference theme.

It is our honour to organise EAMSC twice in the year 2009 and 2010 respectively.

Malaysian Medical Students' Conference (MMSC)

The Malaysian Medical Students' Conference (MMSC) is a national conference that gathers all the Malaysian medical students from different medical schools locally and overseas to discuss the current health and medical issues in Malaysia. This programme is able to instill the critical thinking skills for a lifelong education. It aims to train the medical students to be competitive, capable and innovative at the national and international level. Apart from that, the participants will be introduced to the health-related knowledge in Malaysia and be given the opportunity to share and exchange the thoughts in order to reach a better solution on the issues discussed. It improves the communication skills among medical students to produce skilled and experienced graduates.

Besides activities which are academic and research-based, the conference includes activities which highlight the social and cultural aspects. This will further strengthen the friendship among the medical students and subsequently promote cooperation and enhance communication skills among doctors-to-be from nationwide.

It was first organised at Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia Medical Centre (UKMMC) in the year 2016.

Medics Intervarsity Games (MIVG)

The Medics Intervarsity Games (MIVG) is an annual intervarsity sports event under AMSA Malaysia. This sports tournament was initiated in the year 2009 with the aim of promoting a healthy lifestyle among medical students. It is also aimed to promote and foster intervarsity relations across medical schools in Malaysia. With this, AMSA Malaysia hopes to instill a sense of camaraderie among the future doctors, thus creating a conducive environment for better healthcare practices in the future and to culture wholesome healthcare practitioners in terms of intellectual and personality

World Primary Immunodeficiency Week (WPIW)

World PI Week is a global campaign which aims to raise awareness and improve diagnosis and treatment of primary immunodeficiencies (PI). As for Malaysia, WPIW has been organised in collaboration with The Malaysian Patients Organisation for Primary Immunodeficiency (MyPOPI) since 2015. Now, WPIW has become one of the annual public health programmes of AMSA Malaysia. WPIW offers an opportunity to inform and educate health policy-makers, schools and families, and the general public about primary immunodeficiencies (PI) to drive the earliest possible diagnosis and the optimal treatment. Through events and activities promoting the warning signs of PI, the global PI community can unite to bring about positive changes in healthcare systems and practices around the world in support of people living with PI

Asian Medical Students' Exchange Programme

The Asian Medical Students' Exchange Programme – more commonly known as AMSEP – is an integral programme unique to AMSA. The programme allows members of AMSA to participate in a 5-10 day preclinical or clinical exchange to a chapter of their liking. The idea was first established in 2003.

The programmes and activities during an AMSEP vary, subject to discussion by the involved parties. Nonetheless, AMSEP intrinsically roots back to AMSA's philosophy: Knowledge, Action, and Friendship. Key academic components include workshops, keynote lectures, hospital visits, guided hands-on clinical practice, training, academic discussions, learning about the local healthcare or medical education system, etc. Participating students are also expected to give back to the local community through social service activities that employ their medical knowledge. To add, the students will also experience the wondrous cultural aspects of the destination country, which includes visiting iconic landmarks, savouring the local cuisine, and much more. Above all, however, AMSEP allows participants to form life-time, international friendships with those they meet during the exchange.

European-Asian Medical Students' Exchange Programme

The European-Asian Medical Students' Exchange Programme (EAMSEP) is an exchange programme in collaboration with European Medical Students' Association (EMSA). The first pilot EAMSEP was organised by AMSA Malaysia by welcoming medical students from Lithuania in August of 2014.
